









<b>monarchy</b>	A form of government with a monarch at the head		
<b>empire</b>	An extensive group of states or countries ruled over by a single monarch		
<b>urbanisation</b>	The process of making an area more urban		
<b>industrialisation</b>	The development of industries in a country or region in a wide scale		
<b>workhouse</b>	Provided work and shelter for the poverty stricken.		
<b>government</b>	A group of people with the authority to govern a country or state.		
<b>poor</b>	Lacking sufficient money to live at a standard considered comfortable		
<b>slum</b>	Unhealthy, unsafe and overcrowded housing.		
<b>education</b>	A process of teaching, training and learning.
