Maundy Thursday	The day remembering when Jesus had the Last Supper with his disciples and washed their feet.																	
Good Friday	The day remembering when Jesus was crucified and died at Calvary (an area just outside of the walls of Jerusalem).																	
Easter Sunday	The day remembering when Jesus was resurrected from the dead.																	
joy	An emotion of great happiness.																	
sadness	The act of being sad.																	
vestments	Robes worn by Church leaders during services.																	
liturgical colours	The colours used to represent different times within the Christian calendar year.
