

form	The shape of an object, one of the seven elements used to create a piece of work.	<p><u>Four Rules of Shading</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Shade in one direction. 2. Keep tones smooth – use your finger to blend the shading. 3. Make sure that there are no gaps. 4. shadow art	A type of sculptural art that uses shadows to create an artistic effect.		
technique	A practical method or process used to create a piece of art.

media	The type of material used by an artist to create the piece of work. e.g. charcoal, paint, pencil.		
tone	The lightness and darkness of a colour.		
craft	A skill in making things, especially with hands.		
puppet	A doll moved by your hands or strings.		
sketching	A fast, light drawing which is often used as a plan for drawing or painting.		
shading	Using darker pencil marks to show the darker tones.
