Creation	When God created the world, as told in the book of Genesis.
Fall	When Adam and Eve ate the forbidden apple and broke humans' relationship with God.
Genesis	The first book of the Old Testament.
forgiveness	The act of forgiving someone or being forgiven.
apologise	To say sorry for your actions.
Commandments	The rules given by God to Moses.
relationship	When two or more people are connected in some way.
nature	The natural world, but also what people are like.
parable	Stories told by Jesus to teach a message.
behaviour	The way people act, especially towards other people.

The Creation Story



Important knowledge

- I can place the concepts of God, Creation and the Fall on a timeline of the Bible's 'Big Story'.
- I can make clear links between Genesis 1 and what Christians believe about God and Creation.
- I can describe what Christians do because they believe God is Creator.
- I can suggest what might be important in the creation story for Christians living today, and for people who are not Christians.
- I can describe how and why Christians might pray to God, say sorry, forgive and ask for forgiveness.
- I can make links between what stories in the Bible say about human beings, and my own ideas about how people should behave.
- I know Christians believe that as human beings are part of God's good creation, they do best when they listen to God.
- I know Christians believe that the Bible shows that God wants to help people to be close to him.
- I know how humans spoiled their relationship with God and how they need his help to get close to him again.
- I know Christians show that they want to be close to God, through obedience and worship, which includes saying sorry for falling short.
