function	The purpose or role that an object fulfills.		
finish	Finishing touches added to a product's surface to improve its functionality.		
annotate	Notes that explain what is happening or the components.		
adapt	To change or adjust for a particular use.		
applique	When pieces or patches of fabric are sewn or stuck onto a larger piece of fabric to form a picture or pattern.		
seam allowance	Seam allowance is the area between the fabric edge and the stitching line on two (or more) pieces of material being sewn together.		
texture	The feel, appearance or consistency of a material.		
decorative	To make something look more attractive.		
pattern pieces	A flat template, made of paper or card, that is used for cutting the separate pieces of a garment.
