<b>accuracy</b>	Aiming at then hitting the target.	
<b>evaluate</b>	Comment on own and others performance.	
<b>fundamental movements</b>	Basic traveling skills of badminton.	
<b>strength</b>	How strong you are.	
<b>reaction</b>	How you respond to something.	
<b>defensive clear</b>	A defensive overhead show that is used to defend your area.	
<b>forehand serve</b>	A shot used to start a match.	
<b>flight</b>	When the shuttlecock is travelling through the air.
