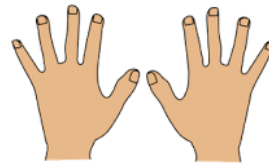

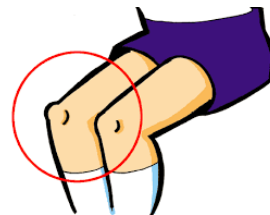

## Important knowledge about Family Tree and Faces

- ❑ The plural word for "the" in Spanish is "los" or "las". "S" is often the letter added to end of the noun to make the plural ending of the noun e.g. la mano/las manos
- ❑ When we say and write colours as adjectives after the noun in Spanish, the spelling changes to match the noun.
