Torah Scroll	This is the first part of the Jewish Holy Text and is written on a scroll – it contains the first five books of Moses		
Hadith	A collection of stories in the Qur'an about Muhammad's life and teachings.		
prophecies	Prophets in the Old Testament were spoken to by God to spread His word. They made prophecies (predictions) about things that would happen in the future.		
Messiah	The promised saviour of the Jewish nation prophesied in the Old Testament		
fulfil(led)	To achieve something or make something happen		
Gentiles	People who are not Jewish		
compulsory	Something you have to do; you don't have a choice.		
Roman Catholicism	A denomination of Christianity based at the Vatican in Rome. The Pope is the leader of the Catholic Church.		
Magnificat	The hymn of praise of the Virgin Mary when she found out she was pregnant with Jesus.
