<b>CEOP</b>	CEOP is the Child Exploitation and Online Protection Centre. <b>flattery</b>	Flattery is when someone says really, really nice things about you.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know different tactics someone might use to pressurise or manipulate another person online.

<b>manipulate</b>	To manipulate is to control or influence (a person or situation) cleverly.		
<b>pressurising</b>	To strongly persuade someone to do something they do not want to do.		
<b>inappropriate</b>	Inappropriate is something that is not suitable in the circumstances.		
<b>public</b>	Anything that can be accessed by everyone.		
<b>tactics</b>	The methods used to achieve what you want in a situation.
