<b>Nazi</b>	A member of the National Socialist German Workers' Party led by Adolf Hitler.		
<b>empire</b>	An extensive group of states or countries ruled over by a single monarch or sovereign state.		
<b>Home Front</b>	The civilian population of a nation at war.		
<b>ally/allies</b>	A state co-operating with another for a military. The Allied countries were United Kingdom, France and the USA and Russia.		
<b>axis</b>	The alliance of Nazi Germany, Italy and Japan established in 1936 and lasting until their defeat in 1945.		
<b>propaganda</b>	Information of a biased or misleading nature used to promote a political cause or point of view.		
<b>Blitz</b>	A German bombing campaign against the United Kingdom.
