<b>precautions</b>	A measure taken to prevent something dangerous happening.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can make adjustments to my structures in order to make improvements.
<b>protection</b>	The act of keeping something safe.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can use secateurs to cut sticks to a certain length.
<b>sheath knife</b>	A small, fixed, blade knife.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can create a map to replicate the forest area.
<b>sustain</b>	To strengthen and maintain something.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can use a Mora sheath knife to whittle a stick.
