The Friends of St. Philip's are excited to announce the Colour Run 2024 this summer! It is the biggest event of the year and open to all pupil age groups, parents, and siblings! The Colour Run is an event inspired by the Hindu festival, Holi.

Tickets for pupils, older siblings (11+) and adults wishing to race are priced at £10 each, which includes entry to the race, warm up introduction, the paint powders thrown at each station and a medal. We will also be hosting a toddler water race for younger siblings (excluding powder) tickets for toddlers wishing to join in the water race are £2. Spectators can enter the event for free.

FOST are delighted to welcome Paul at Prism this year to film our event and capture all the fun the children will be having on the day, this will be shared as a keepsake.

We are hoping to be able to raise some vital funds for the school on the day too so will be having extra treats outside the infant playground, on the car park and by St. Philip's Church.

The colour run will take place on the school field, each year group will run separately to ensure everyone can run the course and enjoy the day as safely as possible. To book your places, simply use out **NEW ONLINE BOOKING** system.

Once you have booked your tickets you will be emailed your ticket confirmation and online waivers to complete. Please ensure you bring your confirmation on your phone or device on the day, waivers for each participant must be completed no later than 5 days before the race to be eligible to compete.

We do advise booking as early as possible as places are limited.

To get the best out of the day, all racers are encouraged to wear a plain white t-shirt so the colour powder will show up better. Protective glasses will be provided. The colour powder is non-toxic/ non-hazardous, eco-friendly and non-flammable.
