



<p>empire</p> <p>An extensive group of states or countries ruled over by a single monarch.</p>	<p>Some innovations during the Victorian era</p>	
<p>urbanisation</p> <p>The process of making an area more urban.</p>	 <p>light bulb telephone Christmas cracker</p> <p>bicycle postage stamp gramophone (music player) typewriter</p>	
<p>industrialisation</p> <p>The development of industries in a country or region in a wide scale.</p>	<p>Manchester during the Industrial Revolution</p>	
<p>workhouse</p> <p>Provided work and shelter for the poverty stricken.</p>		
<p>government</p> <p>A group of people with the authority to govern a country or state.</p>		
<p>poor</p> <p>Lacking sufficient money to live at a standard considered comfortable.</p>		
<p>slum</p> <p>Unhealthy, unsafe and overcrowded housing.</p>		
<p>education</p> <p>A process of teaching, training and learning.</p>
