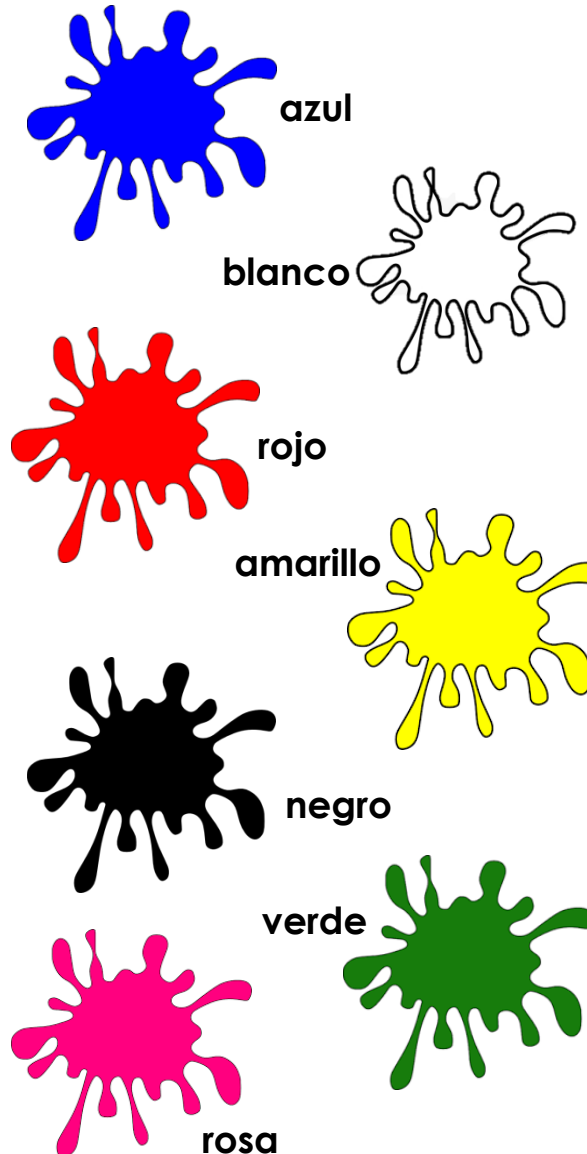


# Year 3: A New Start
